In this difficult time of your life, you may be confused by the complexity of the healthcare system. Our Breast Health Patient Navigation Program can help.

Our program is dedicated to underserved women in the Lowcountry. The Patient Navigator nurse is joined by community “lay” navigators to aid women in the Sea Island and rural Lowcountry community. Navigators will assist with screenings, treatments, appointments, follow-ups, and community education.
